

Admissions criteria

- Applications will be considered according to the published admissions criteria
- Each applicant will be placed in a band according to their admissions score – best of AQE or GL
- First 120 applicants admitted based on band order
- We apply oversubscribed criteria within a band when we receive 120+ applications
- First preference applications are the most secure route to entry
- Consider combinations of criteria, including the advantage of coming from a listed feeder primary school
