Connecting a Chromebook to C2k Wireless

Overview

This information sheet explains the steps required to connect a Chromebook to C2k Wireless. This is a first-time only activity and would only need to be carried out again when the user account password has changed.

Prerequisites for connecting to C2k Wireless:

C2k User account must be a member of Meru C2k Wireless security group

Alternatively, for shared devices you can use the **shared accounts** located at C2k Exchange | My School | School Documents | Guest Wireless Folder.

Connecting the Chromebook

- 1. Power on Chromebook and in the Chrome signin/network window, log in as normal using your Google credentials or log in as Guest.
- 2. Click the WiFi icon in the bottom right of the screen and connect to the C2kwireless network. A settings dialogue will be displayed please ensure the following is entered:

EAP Method – PEAP
Phase 2 Authentication – MSCHAPv2
Server CA Certificate – Do not check
Identity – c2ken\<username>
Password – C2k password
Click Connect button

- 11. The Chromebook will now connect to C2k Wireless
- 12. Once signed in you will be able to browse internet, download apps etc...
