
Connecting a Google Nexus to C2k Wireless

Overview

This information sheet explains the steps required to connect a Google Nexus to C2k Guest Wireless. This is a first-time only activity and would only need to be carried out again when the user account password has changed.

Prerequisites for connecting to C2k Wireless:

C2k User account must be a member of **Meru C2k Wireless** security group

Alternatively, for shared devices you can use the **shared accounts** located at C2k Exchange | My School | School Documents | Guest Wireless Folder

Connecting the Google Nexus

1. Power on Google Nexus and swipe down to display Quick Settings
2. Tap the **Settings** option
3. Within Settings, tap **WiFi** option
4. In the list of wireless networks, tap **C2kwireless**
5. C2k Wireless connection information dialog is then displayed.
 - Ensure EAP Method is set to **PEAP**
 - Ensure Phase 2 Authentication is set to **MSCHAPV2**
 - In the Identity field enter the C2k Username
 - Scroll down
 - In the Password field enter C2k password
 - Tap **Done** in the keyboard
6. System will now connect to C2k Wireless
7. Tap the Home button
8. System is connected – Chrome, Play Store etc..should now be accessible
