
Connecting an Android device to C2k Wireless

Overview

This information sheet explains the steps required to connect an Android to C2k Guest Wireless. This is a first-time only activity and would only need to be carried out again when the user account password has changed.

Prerequisites for connecting to C2k Wireless:

C2k User account must be a member of **Meru C2k Wireless** security group

Alternatively, for shared devices you can use the **shared accounts** located at C2k Exchange | My School | School Documents | Guest Wireless Folder

Connecting the Android (e.g. Samsung Galaxy Tab A)

1. Power on Galaxy Tab device and in the home screen swipe down and tap the **Settings** icon.
2. Within Settings, go to **Wi-Fi** component
3. In the list of wireless networks, tap **C2kwireless**
4. C2k Wireless connection information dialog is then displayed.
 - Ensure EAP Method is set to **PEAP**
 - Ensure Phase 2 Authentication is set to **MSCHAPV2**
 - If there is a field for Domain, enter **c2ken.net**
 - Under CA certificate select **Don't validate** or do not check box if presented
 - In the Identity field enter the C2k Username
 - Scroll down
 - In the Password field enter C2k password
 - Tap **Connect** or **Save** button
5. System will now connect to C2k Wireless
6. Tap the Home button
7. System is connected – Internet/Chrome, Play Store etc.. should now be accessible.
