

Connecting Windows 7 to C2k Wireless

Overview

This information sheet explains the steps required to connect a Windows 7 device to C2k Wireless. This is a first-time only activity and would only need to be carried out again when the user account password has changed.

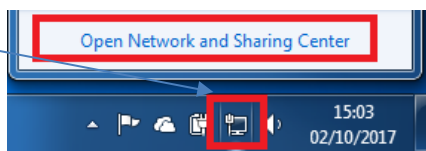
Prerequisites for connecting to C2k Wireless:

C2k User account must be a member of **Meru C2k Wireless** security group

Alternatively, for shared devices you can use the **shared accounts** located at C2k Exchange | My School | School Documents | Guest Wireless Folder.

From the bottom right corner

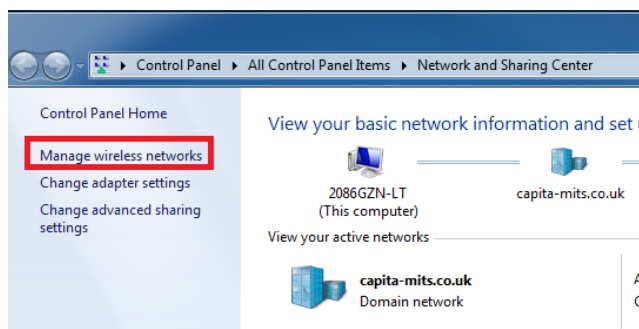
Click the network symbol



Select the Open Network and Sharing Center



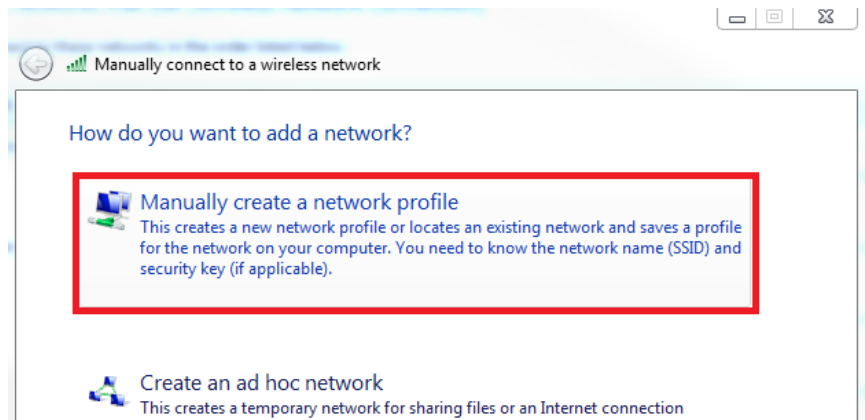
Click the Manage wireless network



Click "Add"



Select! Manually create a network profile



On the next window

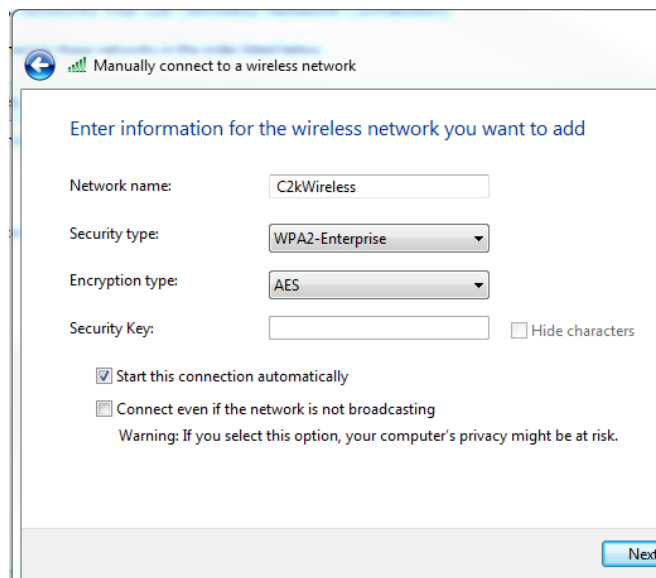
Enter **Network name:** C2kWireless

This has to be case sensitive

Security type: WPA2-Enterprise

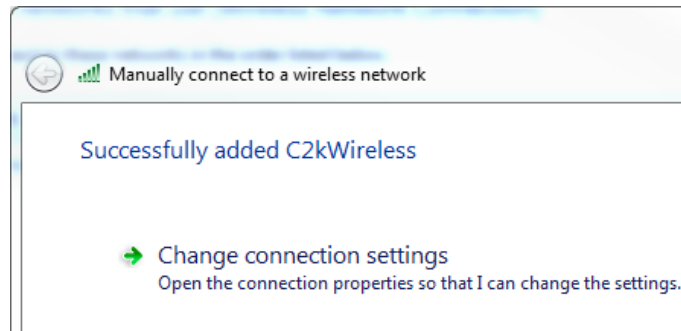
Encryption type: AES

Click! Next

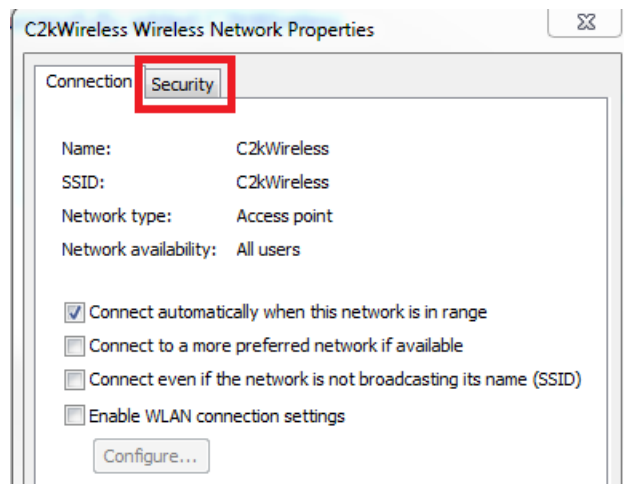


From the next page

Select! Change connection settings

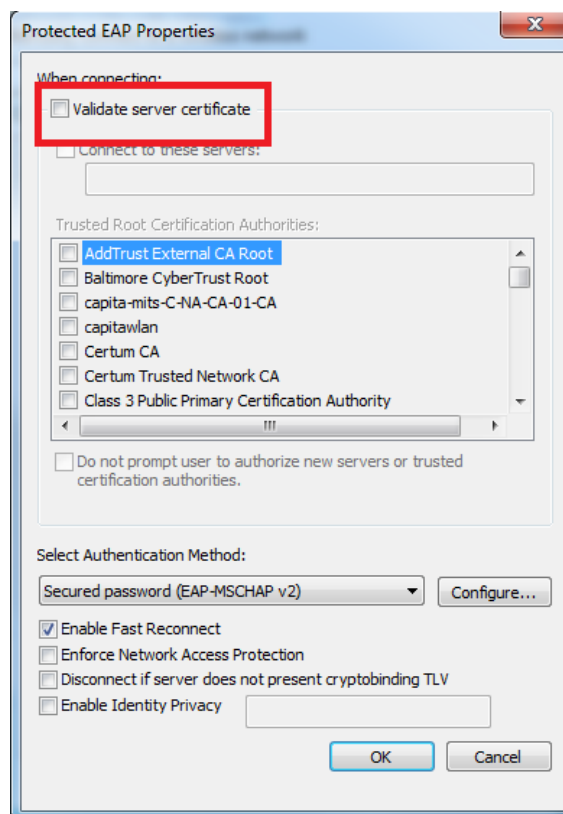


From the next window

Under the security tab

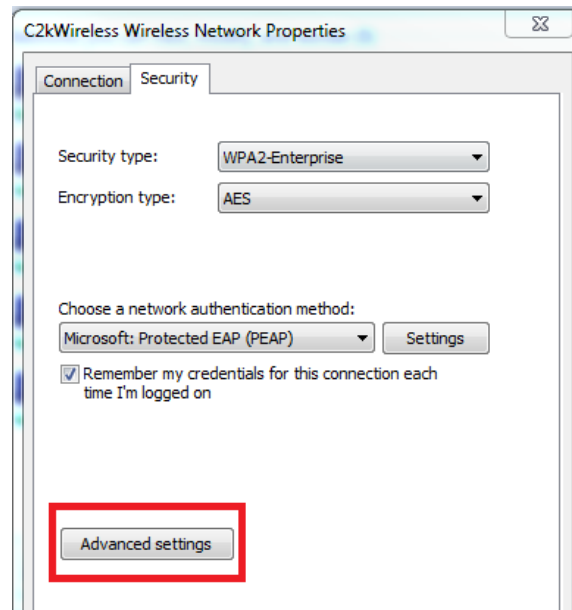
Click | Setting

Untick |Validate server certificate

Click **OK**
On Security page.

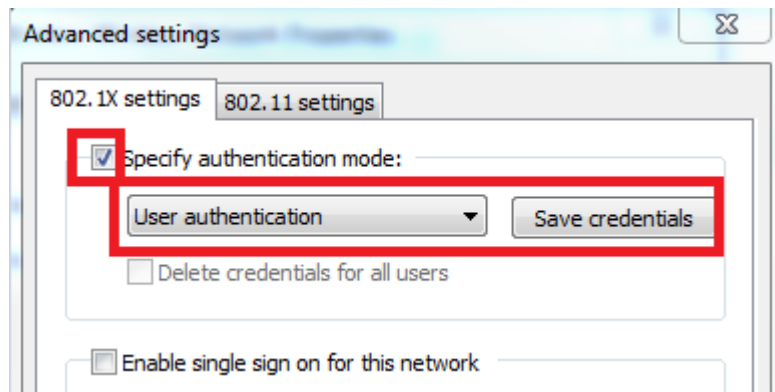


Click **Advanced settings**

Click **Save credentials**



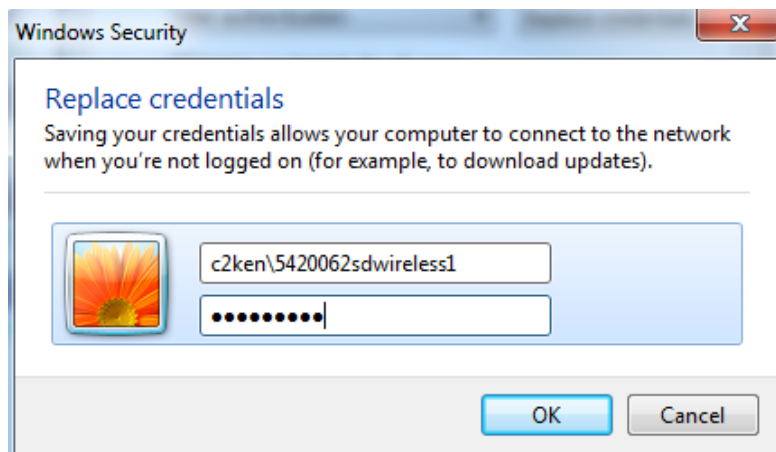
Enter username and password.
