

How to get to Wellington College



Metro

Services via Ormeau/Ravenhill Road:
Approximately every 30 minutes, any of the following routes:

Route 7A/B

Route 77

Route 78

Route 8A Erinvale Avenue/Finaghy Road South via Malone and Stranmillis. Get off and walk up embankment or continue to City Centre and take 7A or 7B.

Train

Travelling by **train** from **Lisburn or Bangor** should disembark at 'Botanic Avenue' station where they can connect with the Four Winds bus.

Service from East Belfast:

Route 188 – Icebowl

Departs Enler Centre Ballybeen, Icebowl, King's Road (Sperrin Park), Gilnahirk Road, Braniel (Farmhurst Green), Whincroft Road, Castlereagh Rd (Conduff), Ladas Drive, Mount Merrion Avenue, Rosetta (St John's Church)

Leaving: A number of buses leaving Enler Centre Ballybeen
From 7:05am onwards
at Icebowl 7:18am, 7:32am, 7:42am

Returning: Leaving Rosetta (Knockbreda Road) at 3:48pm, 3:55pm

Country Routes

Service from Ballygowan:

Route 12 will connect with 188 on Castlereagh Road

Leaving: 7:30am – 7:40am several leaving Ballygowan

Returning: 16:10pm leaving Belfast connecting on Castlereagh Road approx 16:20pm

Public Service from Ballynahinch:

Route 18/20 Newcastle Service to Ballynahinch
(Leaving Ballynahinch @ 7:40am)

Public Service from Saintfield:

Route 15 Downpatrick/Crossgar/Saintfield
(Leaving Saintfield @ 8:00am)

NB **Routes 15/18/20** serve Carryduff – 8:15am

There is also one bus specifically for Wellington pupils leaving Ballynahinch at 7:45am stopping at all stops on route via Carryduff.

NOTE: Translink provide buses which leave from the turning circle at 3:30pm for Ballynahinch, Carryduff and Saintfield. This service is also available on Fridays when the College finishes at 2:45pm. **Translink is unable to provide a specific school service on those days when the College finishes early.**
